

OLD TOWN RUDDER

TOOLS NEEDED

• Wire • Wire Cutters • Philips head screw driver • Allen Wrench

ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Remove factory rudder, bushings and cap screws (Note: Before taking the factory rudder appart, make sure you know what line is Running Rudder Direction, due to how Old Town Rudder will set it up.)
- 2. Place the Bored Bushing and Tapped Bushing on either side of the rudder matching up the holes.
- 3. Place the bolts through the Bored Bushing's recessed holes and tighten through the rudder and out of the Tapped Bushing (DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN)
- 4. Place Rudder handle in down position. Left side cable and rudder should be loose. Right side should be tight.
- 5. Handle the two Screws on lever. (Left is left rudder, Right is right rudder)
- 6. Place Rudder handle in down position.
- 7. Take the knot out of line on handle. Do not cut!
- 8. Loosen bolt, go to back, and pull slight.
- 9. Go to rudder and take bolt out of rudder housing.
- 10. Follow how the rudder line is on the rudder. Do not cut line, just loosen the line.
- 11. Notch on the bottom.
- 12. Thread line as it is on the factory.
- 13. Place back with housing and tighten bolt and screw.
